Think about learning experiences you have had.

Think broadly. Learning isn't only about schools. Learning can result from successes or failures, happy or unhappy occasions, important or seemingly unimportant events. You might include

- moments in your life (the time I played my first solo in college)
- phases of your life (when my family moved to a new town I was 10 years old)
- encounters with people (the time my third grade teacher...)
- events in your life (when my grandfather died)

Let your intuition lead you. You've probably already thought of a few. Pick up to 8 experiences and describe each of them. Describe each experience in a paragraph.

If it is helpful, you can use the following as a template to help guide your description, using 2 or 3 sentences to fill out the details of each prompt:
